FABULOUS FEMINIST LEARNING JOURNEYS

The Fabulous Feminists learning journey is carefully designed to support practitioners at all stages of their development.



LEVEL ONE

Introductory online self-paced courses of between 1 and 2 hours. (Certificate upon completion.)



LEVEL TWO

Interactive, highly participatory courses run over two or more days. Either virtual or in-person. (Certificate upon completion, plus invitation to Fabulous Feminists network.)



LEVEL THREE

Intensive, advanced programme run over several months, combining virtual and in-person learning. (Certificate upon completion, plus invitation to Fabulous Feminists network and opportunity to become an Associate.)

- Reflect on the field of gender training


Who is this for?

How to be a Gender Trainer (Level 2)

Learning Objectives

- Understand the theoretical and conceptual foundations of gender training
- Acquire the basic tools and skills needed for effective gender training
- Explore key areas such as quality standards and evaluation
- Engage with core challenges in the field of gender training such as resistances and online modalities
- Practice the skills acquired in a supportive reflexive learning environment

Who is this for?

This course is suitable for both experienced and emerging gender specialists who would like to develop their training and facilitation skills in a supportive, dynamic environment.



What will participants get out of this?

Following the course, participants will be confident to deliver gender training in their organisations or independently. The course will be delivered via the Fabulous Feminists learning platform, where participants will have access to all course resources and materials, as well as an invitation to join the Fabulous Feminists network.

Advanced Approaches to Gender Training (Level 3)

Learning Objectives

- Explore cutting-edge approaches to gender training
- Practice new tools and techniques in a supportive, safe-brave space
- Work to increase the effectiveness and transformative potential of gender training

Who is this for?

This course is suitable for participants who have already completed "How to be a Gender Trainer" course, or those with a track record of practice in gender training.

What will participants get out of this?

Following the course, participants will be at the forefront of the field of gender training, having explored collectively the potential for transformative training. The course will be delivered partly via the Fabulous Feminists learning platform, where participants will have access to all course resources and materials, as well as an extensive peer network of fellow practitioners.

There will also be an in-person component to the programme, so that participants can practice their advanced skills together in a face-to-face setting.

Participants who successfully complete the course will be issued with a Level 3 certificate from Fabulous Feminists, as well as an invitation to join the Fabulous Feminists network.

On completion of this Level 3 course, participants will have the opportunity to become an Associate of Fabulous Feminists.



Advanced training involves both virtual and in-person elements, for trainers who want to progress substantively in their training practice.

Applied Theatre for Gender Equality and Social Inclusion (Level 2)

Gender-responsive Budgeting: A Participatory Feminist Introduction (Level 3)

Learning Objectives

- Recognition of the potential of financial and fiscal policies to influence gender disparities
- Use participatory feminist pedagogical principles to create a dynamic learning environment that focuses on process, tools and approaches as well as outcomes
- Explore concepts of GRB, existing frameworks, and contributions of international development partners including UN Women, IMF, OECD, PEFA Gender Framework

What will participants get out of this?

Participants will learn key foundations and tools of gender-responsive budgeting in an interactive manner, engaging critical thinking and reflexivity, in line with feminist pedagogical principles.





This interactive, participatory course will equip participants with the practical and analytical tools to apply gender-responsive budgeting (GRB) in their work.

Maja Bosnic is an economist specializing in public financial management and genderresponsive budgeting with 20 years of professional experience in international development projects. During her career, she has cooperated with international financial institutions, bilateral donors and governments around the world - in the area of PFM reforms and GRB. She was a Team Leader of one of the largest global projects on gender-budgeting: Gender **Budgeting in Ukraine Project** funded by Sida (2013-2020). In her work with international finance institutions, including **International Monetary Fund** (IMF) and the World Bank group (WB), she has most recently cooperated with the WB PEFA Secretariat in developing new tools to ensure gender equality is taken up in public finance management processes.
